

## *Santaluz Land Development Project Receives Outstanding Civil Engineering Project Award!*



On Friday, February 21, 2003 **RICK ENGINEERING COMPANY** was presented the Outstanding Civil Engineering Project Award by the San Diego Engineering Coalition and the California Society of Professional Engineers for the Santaluz Land Development Project. **RICK ENGINEERING COMPANY** assumed the lead role working for Santaluz LLC, a partnership of Taylor Woodrow Homes and DMB Associates.

The 4,000-acre site was an untouched, natural setting situated in the soft rolling hills east of Del Mar, and only minutes from the beach. To preserve the natural topographical elements of the landscape, **RICK ENGINEERING COMPANY** created and applied what we term "earth-nested architecture", creating a distinctive setting that makes Santaluz stand apart from other developments.

Today Santaluz not only boasts a championship golf course and more than 1,100 dwellings but many infrastructure improvements like new roadways that connect the I-5 corridor to the I-15 corridor, a 25 million gallon water reservoir, and an improved water distribution system.

The award recognizing this achievement in land development was presented to Tim Murphy, Project Manager of the Santaluz project, of **RICK ENGINEERING COMPANY** at the **National Engineer's Week** dinner held at the Doubletree Hotel in Mission Valley.
